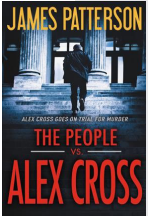

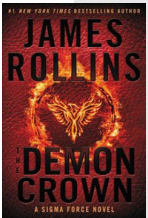
The People vs. Alex Cross James Patterson

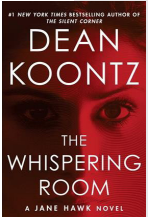
The Demon Crown James Rollins

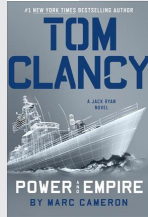
Secrets of Cavendon Barbara Taylor Bradford

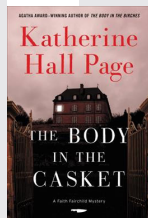
Tom Clancy Power and Empire Marc Cameron

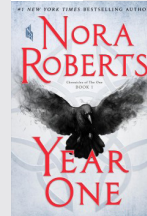
The Body in the Casket Katherine Hall Page

Grant Rob Chernow



Ulysses S. Grant's life has typically been misunderstood. He is often caricatured as either a chronic loser, or as the triumphant but brutal Union general of the Civil War. But these stereotypes don't capture the general and president whose fortunes rose and fell with dizzying speed and frequency. His business ventures ended dismally, he resigned from the army in disgrace amid accusations of drunkenness. But in war, Grant realized his potential, soaring through the ranks of the Union army. He became President Lincoln's most trusted general. His own two-term presidency was plagued by scandals, yet he gained favor with historic figures such as Frederic Douglass and Mark Twain. Chernow finds the threads that bind these stories together, shedding new light on this misunderstood figure.
